AFFILIATION



The School is affiliated to the **Meghalaya Board of School Education (MBOSE)** for the Secondary and Higher Secondary Courses in Arts, and to the Catholic Schools Education Board Diocese of Tura (CSEBTD) for the L.P. and U.P. School Courses.



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HIGHER SECONDARY COURSE (ARTS) :

The school offers Higher Secondary course in Arts with a view to prepare the pupils to pursue Degree and other Higher Studies after the successful completion of **HSSLC**. The duration of the course is two years (**Class XI & XIII**). At the end of the first year, based on the course of studies and questions prepared by **MBOSE** the school conducts **Promotion Examination**, and at the end of the second year the Board (**MBOSE**) conducts the **HSSLC Examination**. Besides, the school conducts regular **Weekly, Unit, and Half Yearly Tests** and other **Internal Assignments** and **Projects**

APPLICATION FORMS:

Application Forms for **Admission to class XI** are issued before or after the result of **SSLC Examination**. The prospectus and applications forms are available at the school office. Forms are to be submitted on or before the notified date. Incomplete and late applications will be rejected.

- Admission is granted on the basis of the **SSLC result** and the performance at qualifying examination and interview of the candidates.
- Names of the selected candidates will be displayed on the **School Notice Board and Website**.
- Selected candidates are to take admission within the due date with the necessary documents and the prescribed fees, **failing which the admission will stand cancelled**.
- Some applicants will be kept on the waiting list. They may be admitted in a later period if vacancies arise due to selected candidates failing to report for admission



DOCUMENTS TO BE ATTACHED:

- Four numbers of recent passport size photographs
- Copy of Marksheet of SSLC Examination.
- Copy of Admit Card and Registration card of MBOSE/Board.
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of Aadhar Card (Candidate).
- Copy of Aadhar Cards (Both Parents).
- If Catholic, Recommendation from Parish Priest.

AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION:

- **Original Transfer Certificate (TC)** from the school last attended.
- Copy of **Character Certificate** from the school last attended.
- For those who change school/ stream, **NOC** from the last school and **PEN (Permanent Education Number)** document from the previous school.
- Prescribed fees.
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CLASSES & ATTENDANCE:

1. Classes will commence on the notified date. If any student absent at the commencement for more the two days without prior information, the admission will stand cancelled.
2. Attendance is compulsory. Every student is required to obtain a minimum seventy-five percent (75%) of attendance in a year. Attendance will be taken for each Lecture. Students with low attendance percentage risk being denied grace marks at the Promotion/Selection Test.

IDENTITY CARD AND UNIFORM:

Identity Card will be issued to each student. Identity Card is to be brought to the school each day and produced for every type of transaction in the school. The Higher Secondary Uniform (**Track Pant, T-Shirt, Blazer**) will have to be purchased from the School. Students shall not stitch these outside.

CODE OF ETHICS AND BEHAVIOR:

Good Shepherd Higher Secondary School aims at integral human formation, and hence certain guidelines of conduct are laid down for forming attitudes and directing conduct. All students shall abide by this code in letter and spirit:

1. Students are to come to the school neatly and decently dressed in the prescribed uniform only.
 2. Use of **Mobile phone by students** within the school premises is strictly forbidden. Violation of this rule will meet with a fine of **Rs. 500/-** and confiscation of the equipment which shall not be returned.
 3. Smoking, pan, alcoholic drinks and drugs are strictly forbidden within and outside campus.
 4. Students shall not wear jewellery or any decorative item. Proper hair style, neat and tidy uniform, shoes and dress is a must on school day.
 5. The school is owned and run by the Catholic Church. No disrespect should be shown to articles or images of religious and worship. No external form of worship other than that of the Catholic Community is permitted in the school premises.
 6. Active participation in the morning assembly and prayer, occasionally conducted all-faith prayer sessions and in other common programmes are expected from every student.
 7. Other general norms/guidelines may be enacted from time to time as and when found necessary.
- All terms and conditions set forth in the prospectus, including fees, are liable to change from year to year.



NOTE TO PARENTS: The support and collaboration of parents/guardians are in all cases considered indispensable to the success of the work of education carried out by the school.

1. At the time of taking admission pupils must be introduced personally to the principal by parents or by one who will be responsible for their regularity, conduct and fees.
2. Parents are to keep track of the performance and progress of their wards in attendance, tests and discipline by occasionally visiting Principal/Headmistress/Teacher-in-Charge

FEES STRUCTURE FOR XI:

At the time of Admission:

- Annual Fees =Rs. 4800/-
- Uniform Accessories =Rs. 1650/-
- Total Amount =Rs. 6450/-**

Tuition Fees: (to be paid in 4 installments)

- 1st Installment: on or before 10th June 2026 = Rs. 1950/-
- 2nd Installment: on or before 30th August 2026 = Rs. 1950/-
- 3rd Installment: on or before 31st October 2026 = Rs. 1950/-
- 4th Installment: on or before 1st December 2026 = Rs. 1950/-
- Total Amount = Rs. 7800/-**

Note:

1. Monthly tuition Fees cover a period of 12 months.
2. Fees should be paid in 4 instalments during the year as mentioned above.
3. All the Annual and monthly tuition fees must be cleared before the promotion Examination (Class XI) and selection Test (Class XII), failing which Admit Cards may not be issued.
4. Fees once paid are not refunded for any reason whatsoever.
5. Capitation fees are not accepted.
